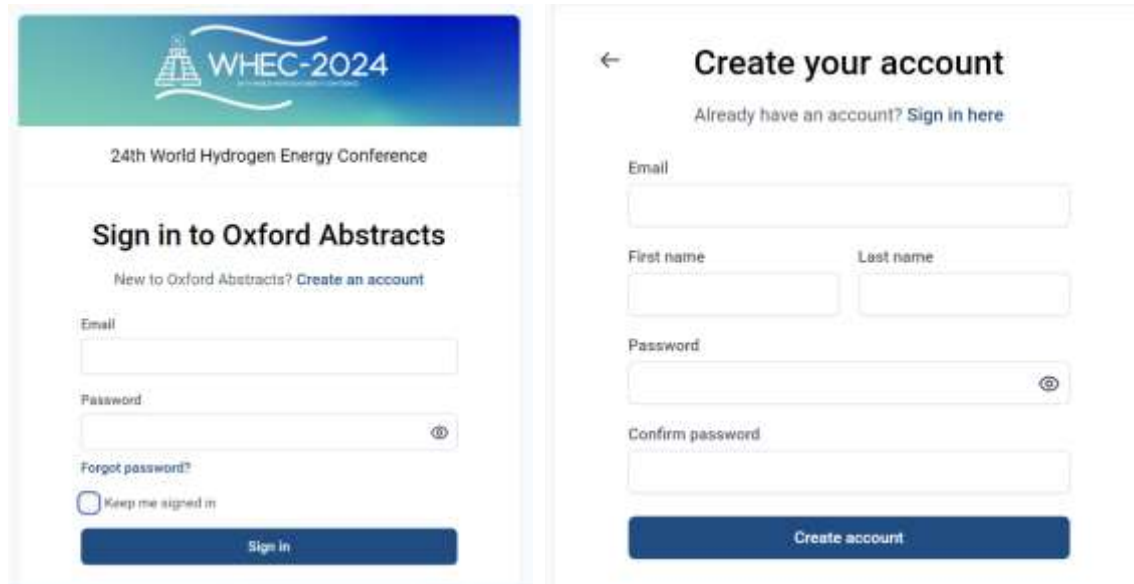


Instructions for Abstract Submission

The abstract submission process will be online by completing the dedicated page for this purpose.
